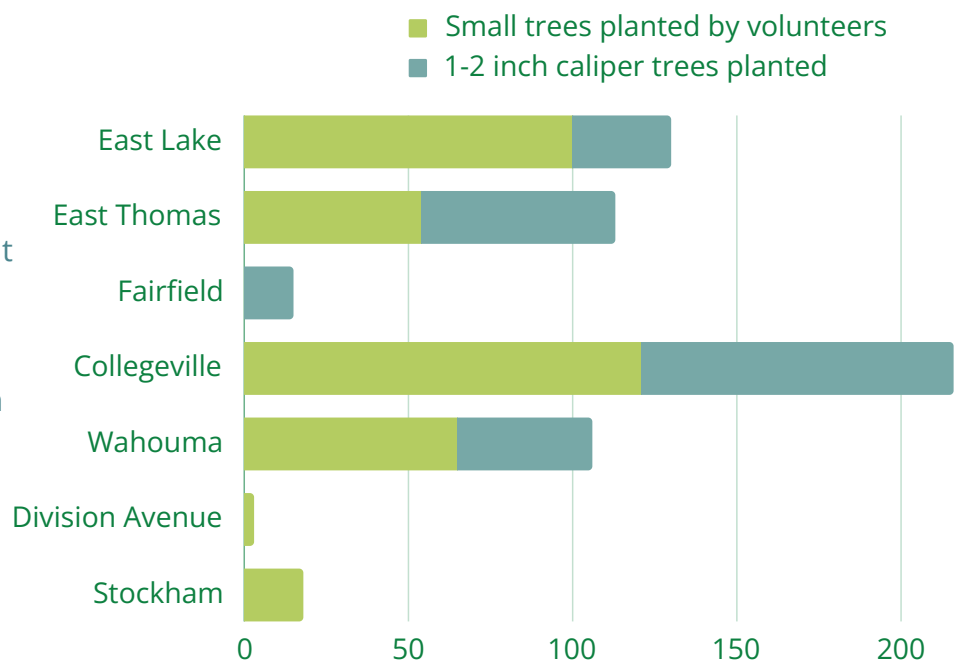
## ~ VISION ~
